
1. Safety Instructions

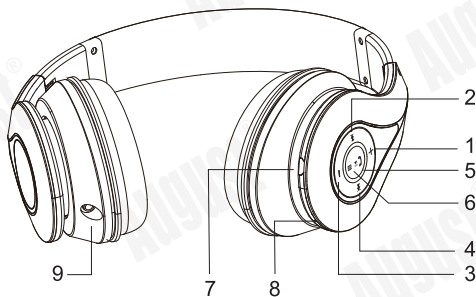

5. Operations

5.1 Switch On / Off

To switch on the device, press and hold the ►|| button for 2 seconds.

To switch off the device, press and hold the ►|| button for 3 seconds. The status LED will flash red then turn off.

5.2 Bluetooth Connections

Turn the device on, the EP640 will automatically reconnect to the last paired Bluetooth device if it is in range. If it is not in range, the EP640 will enter pairing mode automatically. In pairing mode, the LED flashes red and blue. To connect to a new device, disable the Bluetooth connection on the currently connected device.

- For mobile phones

1. Scan for available Bluetooth devices on your mobile phone (see your mobile phone user manual for instructions if needed).
2. Select "EP640" from the available devices and confirm connection.
3. The status LED flashes blue to indicate a successful connection.

Note: Accessing Bluetooth settings on mobile phones varies for each phone, to find the information for your phone, please refer to its user manual.

- For computers

1. Enable the Bluetooth function on your computer.
2. Select "Devices and Printers" from the Control Panel and click "Add a Device".
3. Select "EP640" from the available devices, the system will install the driver automatically.

Note: For Windows XP and Vista, a third-party Bluetooth driver is needed (not included).

4. The status LED flashes blue to indicate a successful connection.
5. If the EP640 is not automatically set as your output device, select "Sound" from the control panel then highlight the EP640 and select "Set Default".

Note: When switched on, the EP640 will automatically reconnect to the last paired Bluetooth device if it is in range.

- Multipoint

Multipoint allows you to connect your EP640 headphones to two source devices at the same time. To create a multipoint connection:

1. Turn off the EP640 and both source devices.
2. Press and hold ►|| for 5 seconds to turn on and put the EP640 into pairing mode. In pairing mode the status LED will flash red and blue.

3. Pair the EP640 to the first source device.
4. Press and hold ►|| for 3 seconds to put the EP640 into pairing mode again. The first source device will be disconnected and the status LED will flash red and blue.
5. Pair the EP640 to the second source device.
6. Turn off the EP640, then press and hold ►|| for 5 seconds to turn it on again. The EP640 will automatically enter reconnection mode and pair to both source devices.

To switch between source devices, pause the music on the current device then play music on the second device. Switching devices can take up to 10 seconds.

Note: When receiving a call on either source device, the music will automatically pause and resume once the call is finished.

- NFC

1. Enable Bluetooth and NFC on your source device.
2. Switch on the EP640 and enter pairing mode.
3. Touch the NFC area of your source device against the NFC area on the left side of the EP640. They will automatically pair with each other.
4. Confirm Bluetooth pairing if prompted. "EP640" will now be listed in your source device's Bluetooth device list.
5. To disconnect your device, touch the NFC area of your device against the NFC area on the left side of the EP640. Touch again to reconnect.

5.3 Remote Control

The EP640 is able to control the music playing on either a mobile phone or a computer with a Bluetooth connection.

Press "►||" to pause or resume playing music.
 Press "+" or "-" to increase or decrease the volume.
 Press "◀◀" or "▶▶" to select the previous or next track.

Note: Music playing control is only compatible with devices that support A2DP, please refer to your devices user manual for its A2DP compatibility.

5.4 Hands-free Calling

Whilst connected to your mobile phone, the EP640 will act as a hands-free system for calls.

Press ►|| to pick up or hang up a call. Press and hold ►|| for 2 seconds to reject the incoming call.
 Press ►|| twice to dial last incoming number.

During a call, double press ►|| to transfer the call between the headphones and your mobile phone.

5.5 Audio-In

To use the EP640 as a pair of wired headphones, use a 3.5mm audio cable to connect the EP640 to your source device. Once the audio cable is connected to the EP640, the device automatically switches to wired mode.

6. Charging

When the power is low, the LED flashes red. To charge the EP640, connect the micro USB lead to the device's power socket, and the other end of the USB cable to a powered USB port.

The status LED lights red whilst charging and turns off once the battery is fully charged.

Note:

- 1) Only use USB power plugs that have been properly certified.
- 2) Make sure that the headphone is fully charged for at least 6 hours for before first use.
- 3) The headphones must be fully charged before use if they have been unused for longer than 1 year.

8. Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Won't turn on.	Please charge the EP640.
Can't find the EP640.	Confirm the EP640 is in pairing status and within 10 meters from the device.
Can't install the driver for EP640.	Update the driver of the Bluetooth module on your computer.
The sound quality is intermittent in Bluetooth mode.	Disable the Wi-Fi on your source device.
No sound.	Check the volume on both the source device and the EP640.
